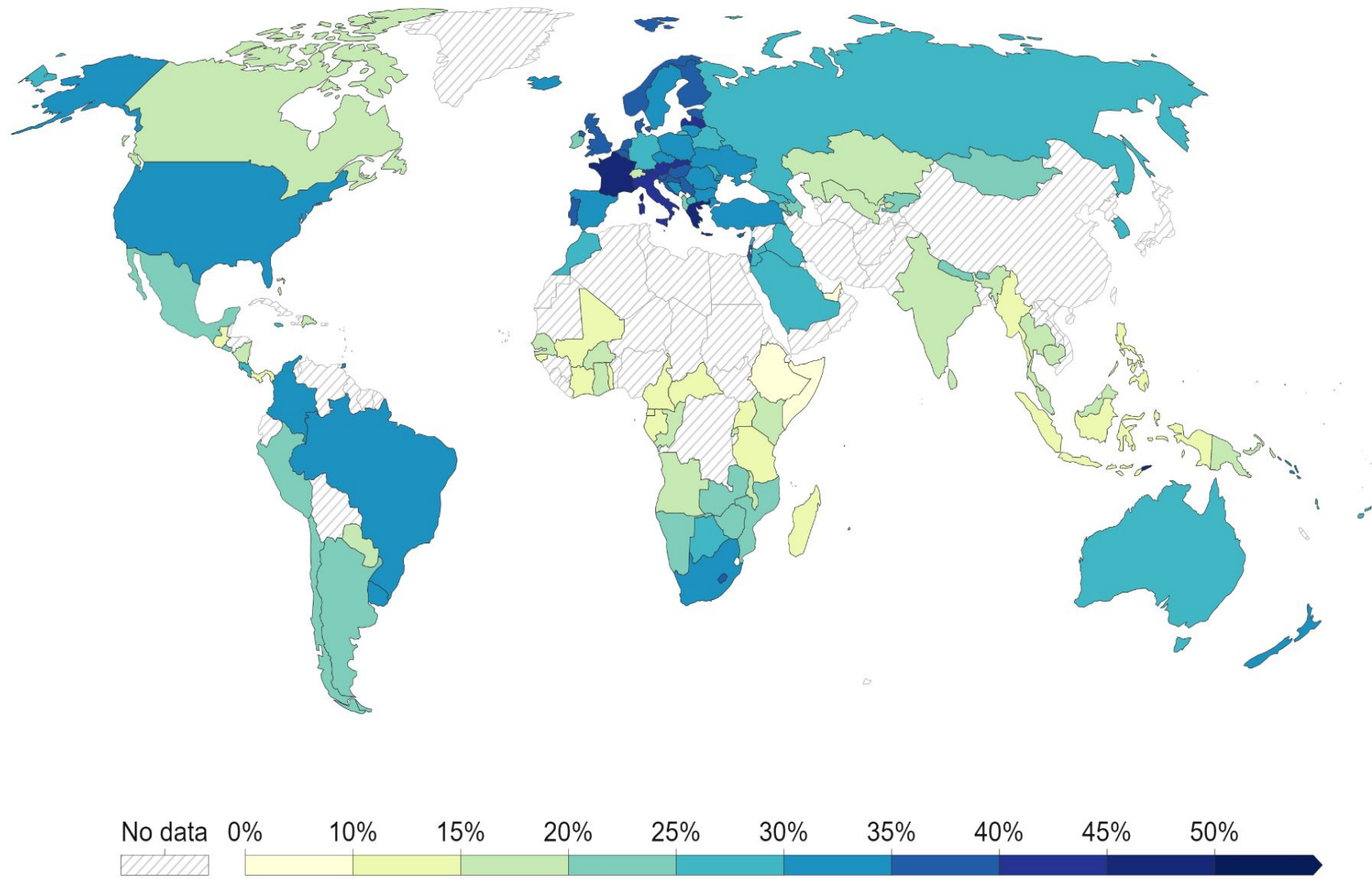

Total central government expenditures (payments for operating activities of the government in providing goods and services), as share of GDP.

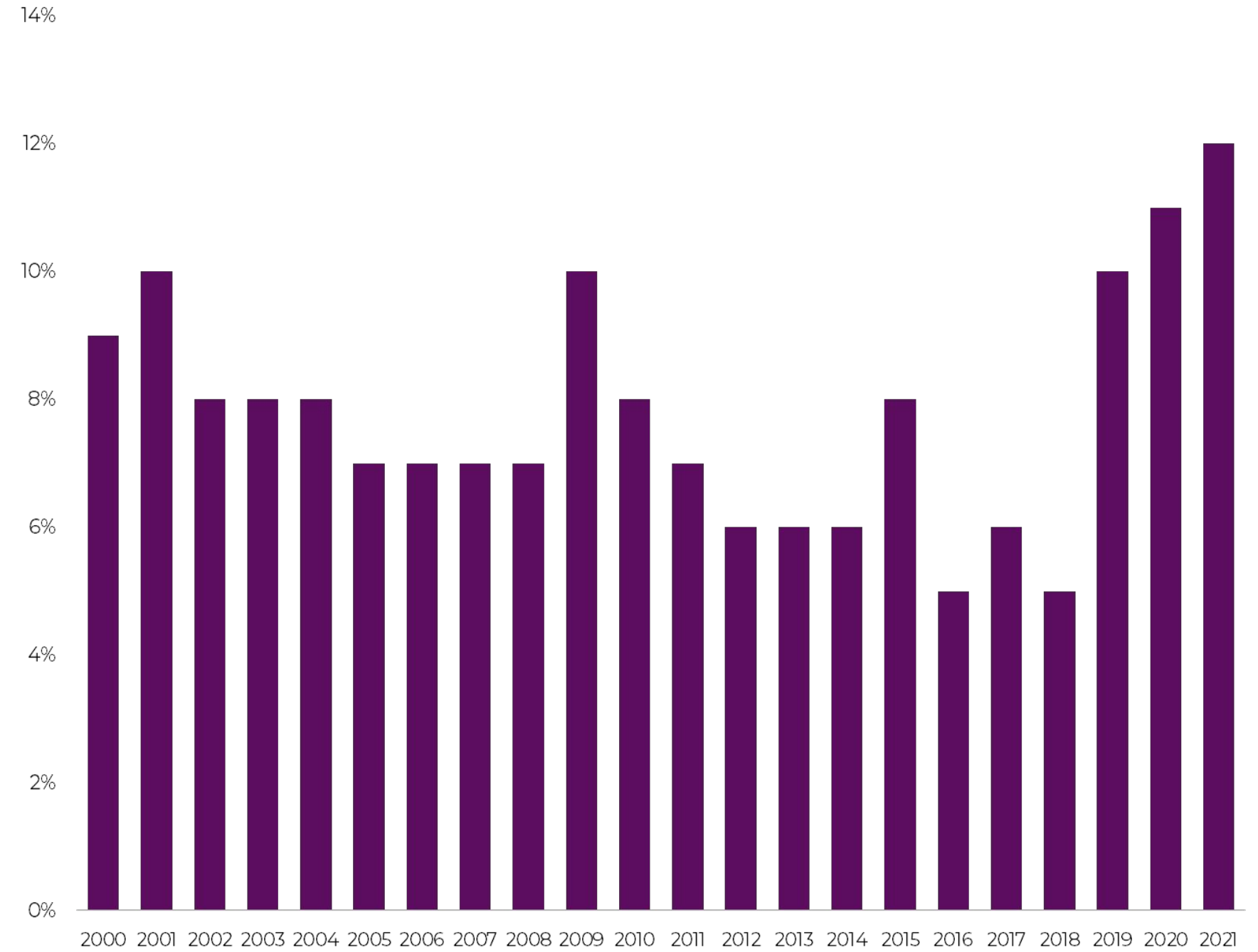

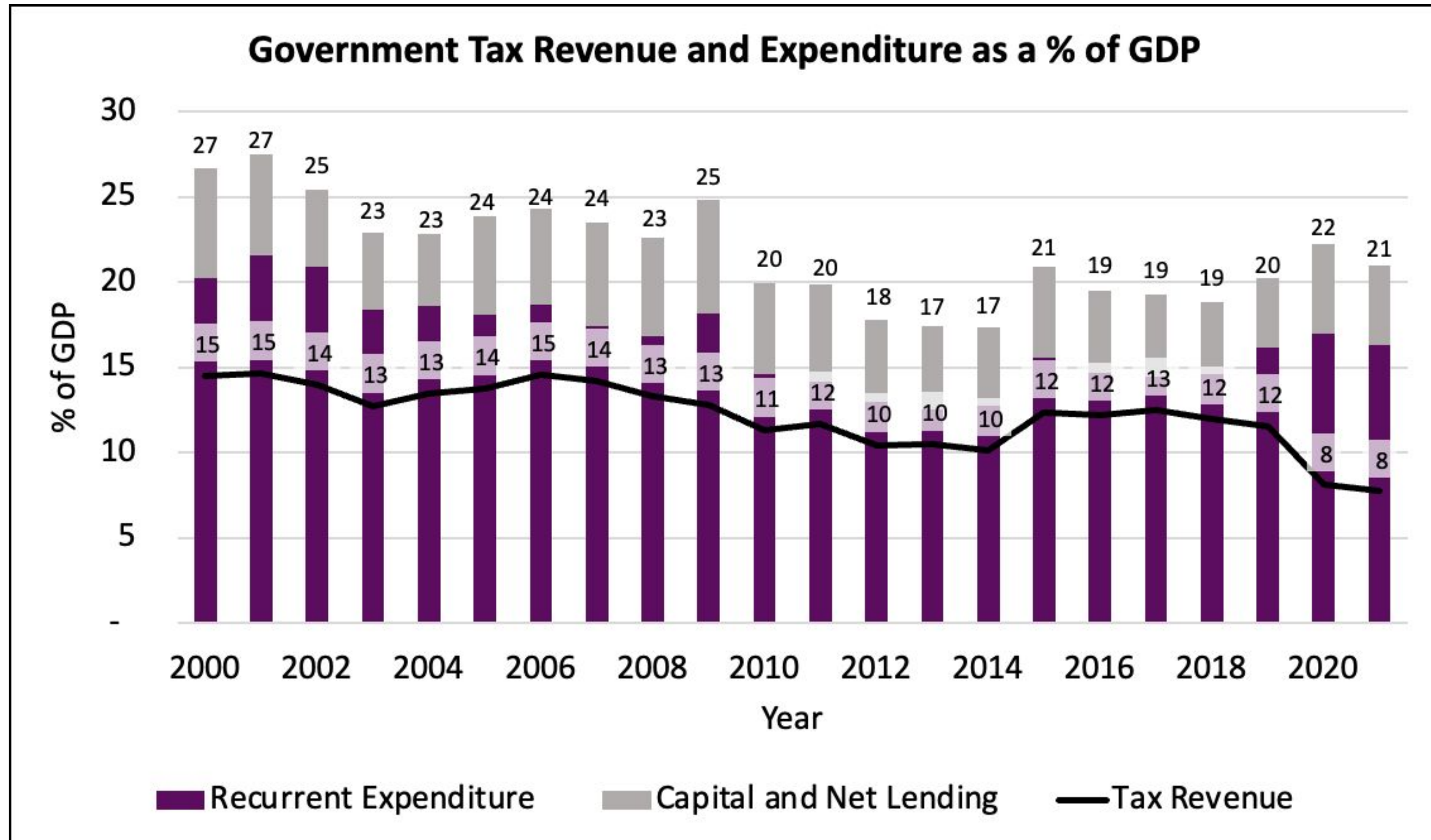

Overall budget deficit as a % of GDP



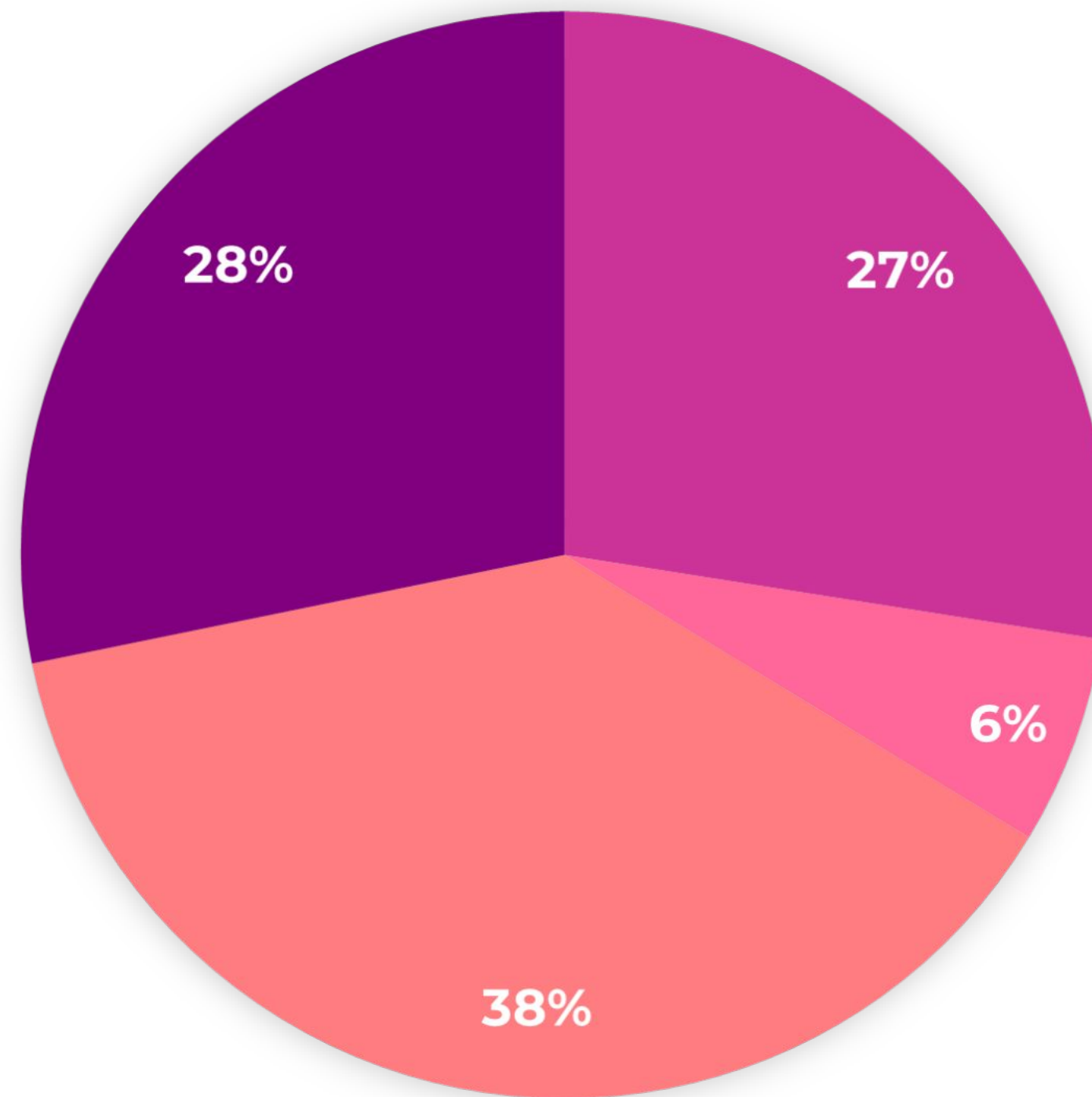

Government Expenditure Over Time



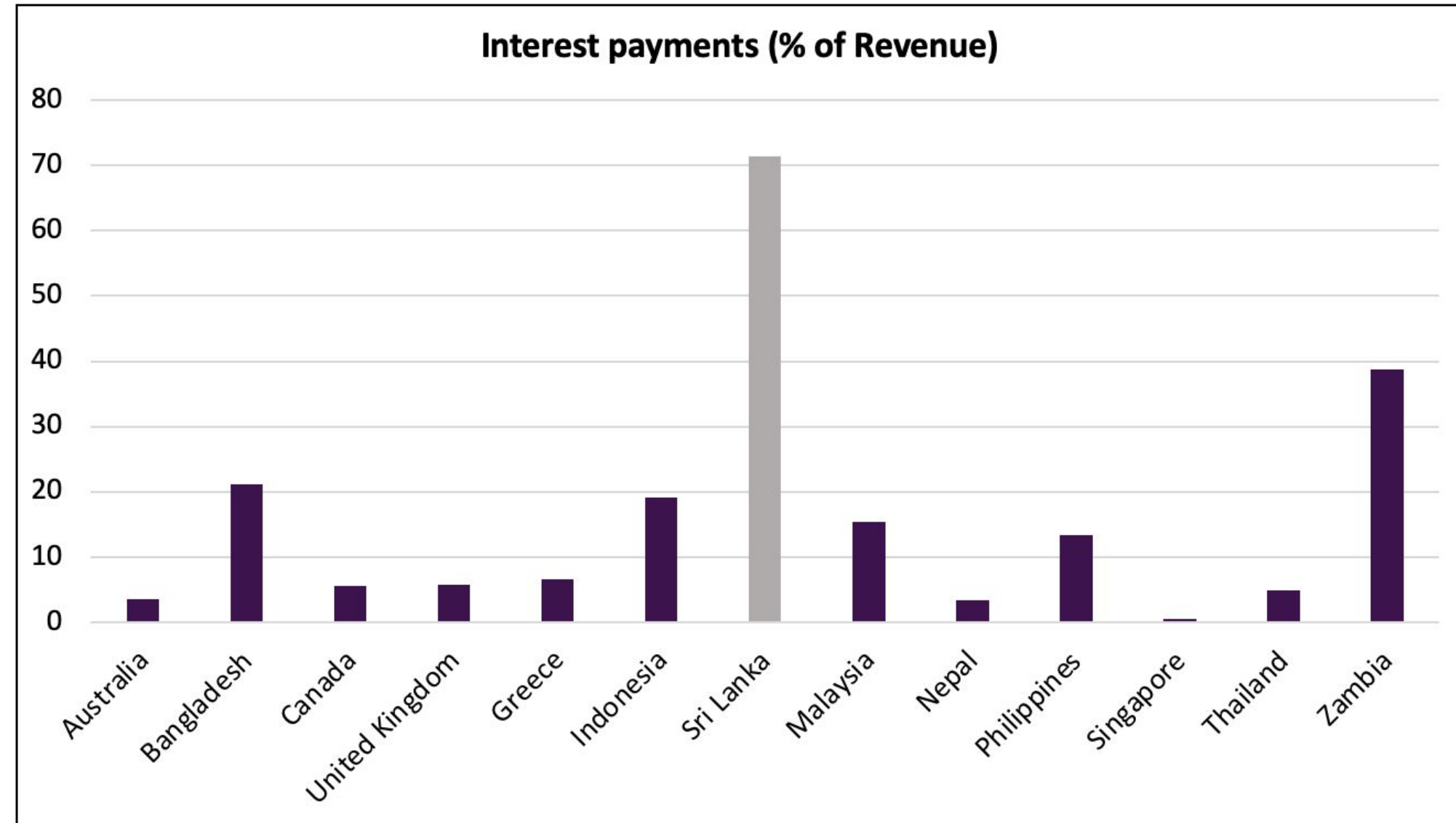
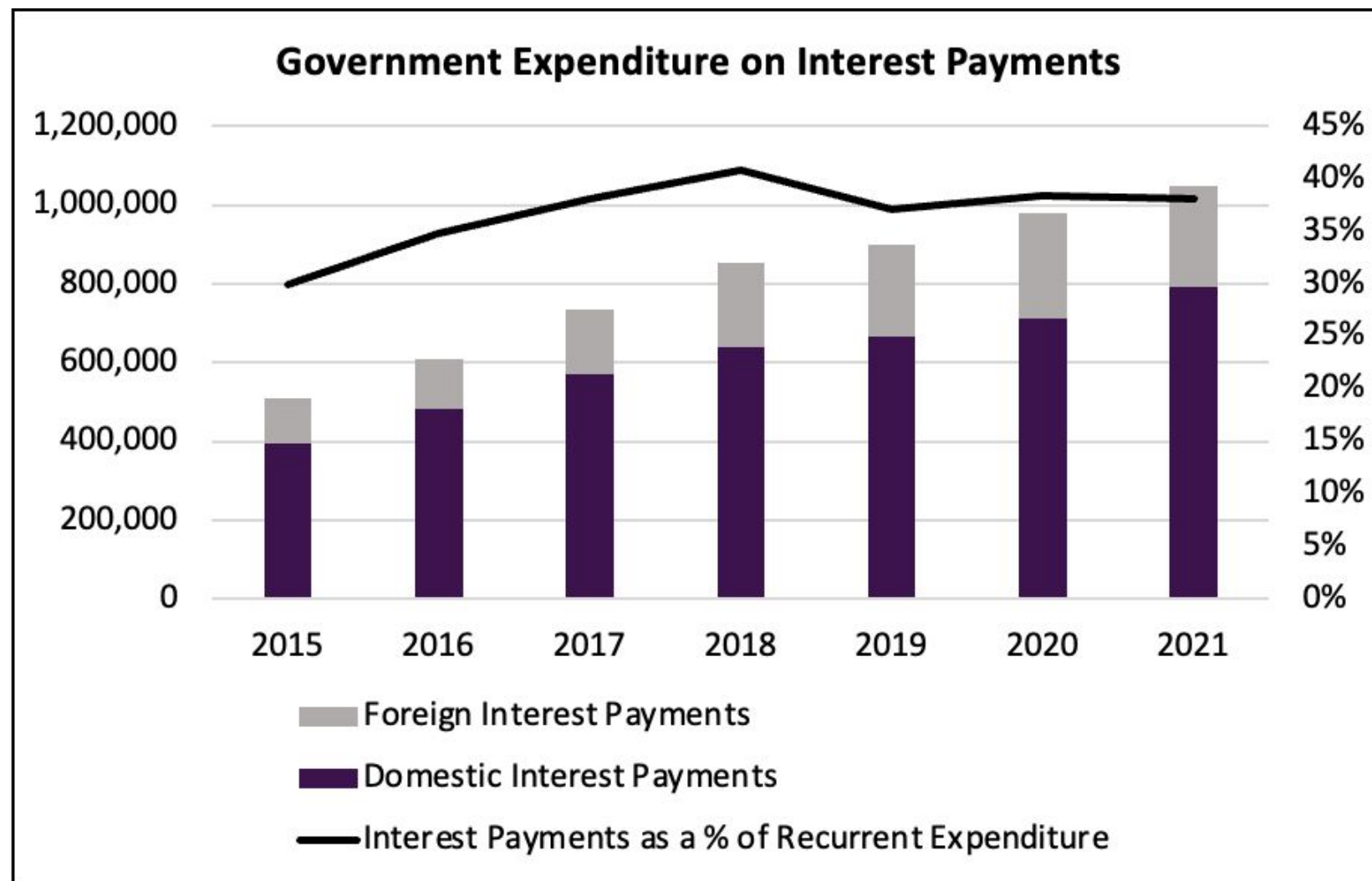
Composition of Recurrent Expenditure

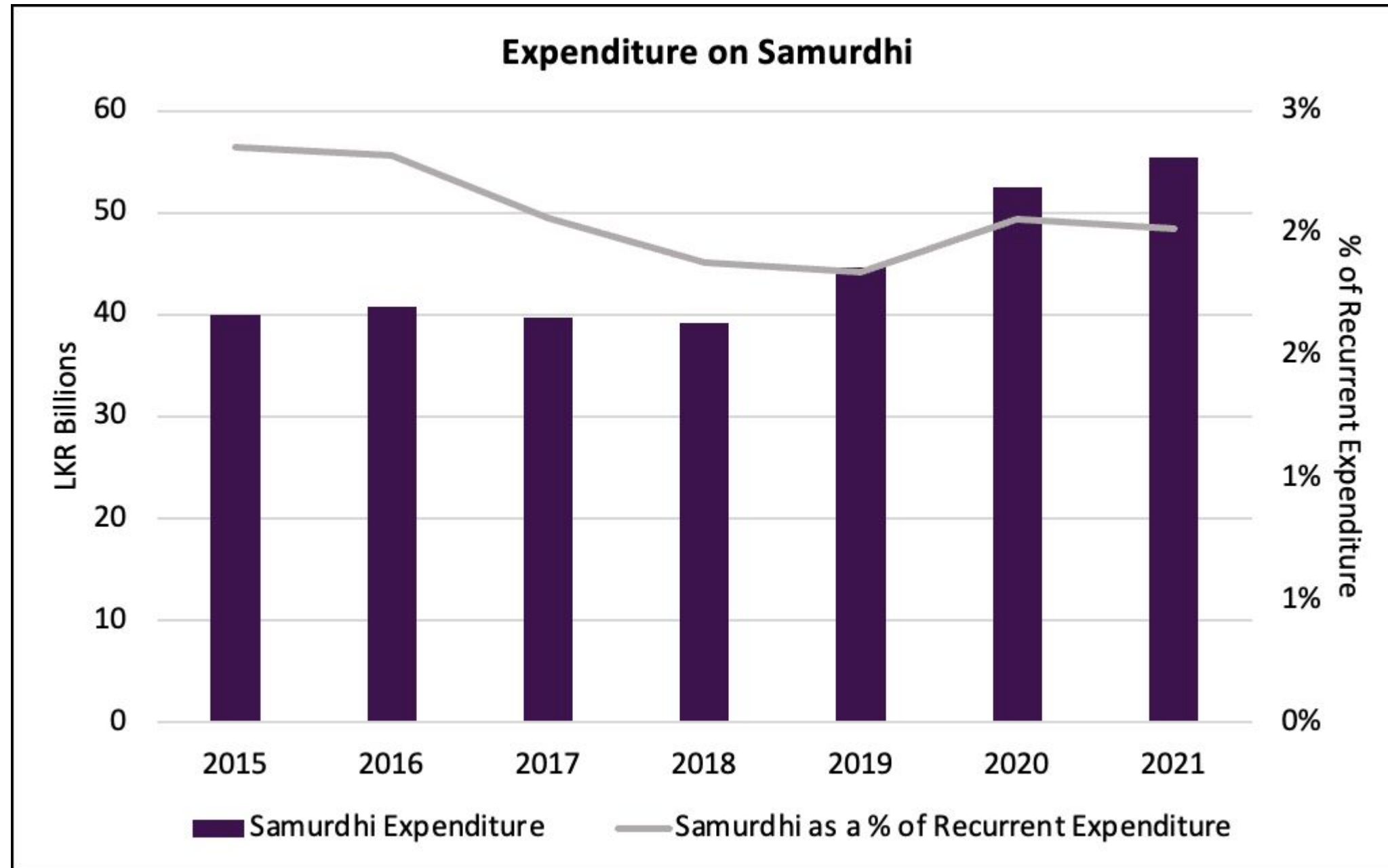
Breakdown of Recurrent Expenditure



■ salaries and wages ■ other goods and services ■ interest ■ subsidies and transfers

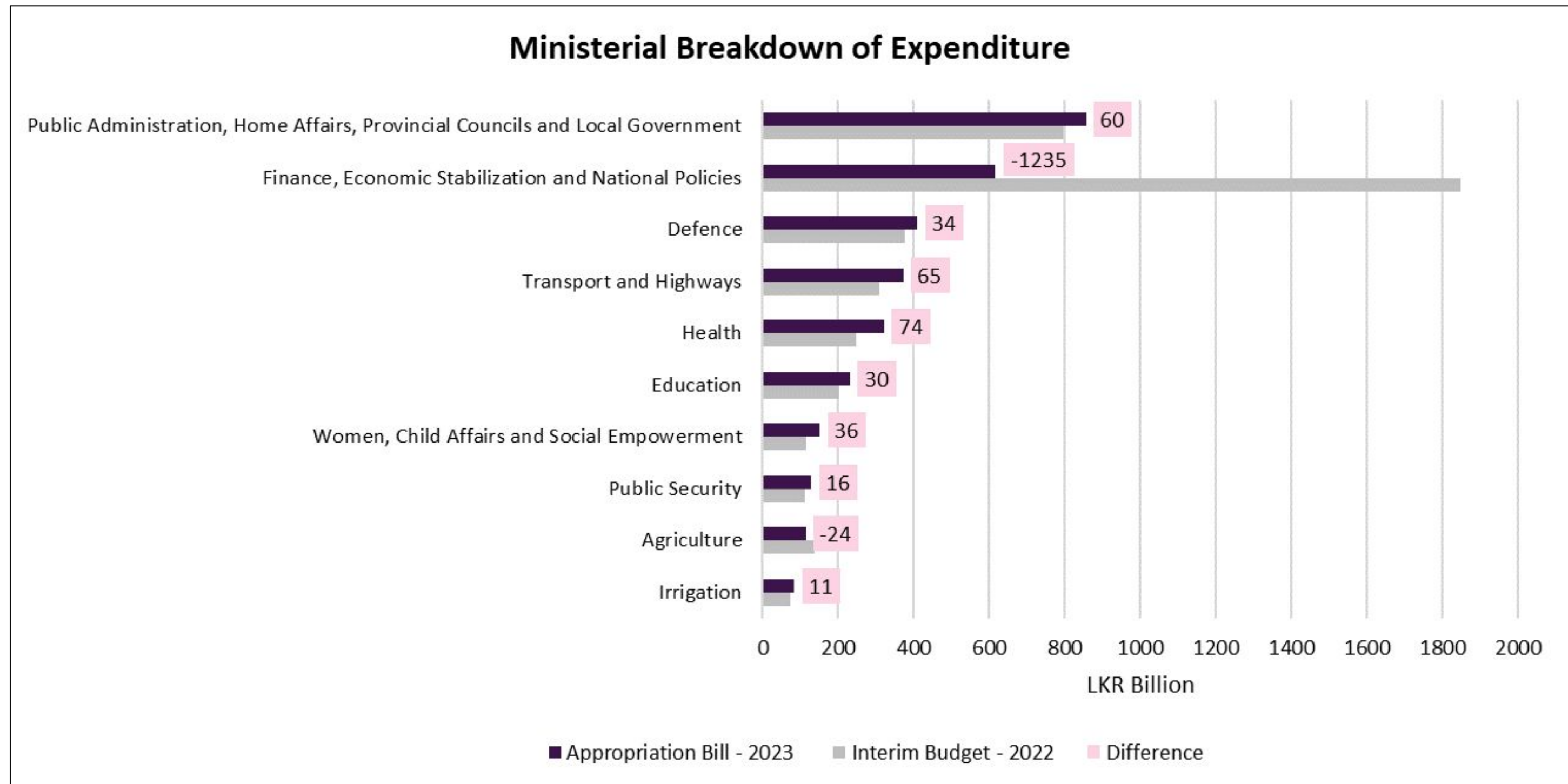
Interest Costs
